GOD IN THREE PERSONS


The month of May closes with that most mysterious, and perhaps confusing, teaching of the Church: Holy Trinity Sunday. The Feast of Pentecost also has us thinking of the persons of the Trinity. But can we say that we know that much of what is, after all, somewhat unknowable? It's been said that Lutherans don't say as much about the Holy Spirit as the more evangelical wing of Christianity. This is perhaps true for what we think of as the more orthodox denominations: Lutheran and Roman Catholic, Anglican and Episcopalian, Methodist and Presbyterian. These churches invoke the Holy Spirit often in worship, and we are well aware of the gifts and fruits of Spirit as we read of them in the Bible, both Christian and Hebrew testaments. It may be that we shy away from diving into the wonders of God's Spirit because of what some Christians practice in their use of various spiritual gifts. Paul warned his audience that speaking in tongues is a tricky gift; when no one is present who might help interpret the words being said in Spirit, then the believers are not built up as they might be when other spiritual and prophetic gifts are practiced. We trust in the indwelling of Spirit, but like many thoughts of God's presence, we can't know it all.

One thing you may have noticed is that when I refer to the third person of the Godhead, I will sometimes leave off the word 'the', as in **the** Holy Spirit. Since Spirit is a person, I think Spirit is a name rather than an identifier, like **the** Father or **the** Son. We can say the Holy Spirit like I will say the Savior Jesus, or Jesus the Christ. But Spirit is a person—in the original Biblical words, Hebrew and Greek, these names are given in the feminine gender. In Hebrew, it is *ruach*, which can also be translated as breath or wind, as in Genesis, chapters 1 and 2. Spirit/ wind moved through the void and swept over the waters to bring about Creation. Then Spirit was breathed into the first beings,

Adam and Eve. What's also true is that the same can be said of the Greek word pneuma – think about the Pentecost reading that features the strong wind sweeping through the midst of the apostles! Note: I will rarely, if ever, use the pronoun *she* in prayers or preaching, but it is in my head, since I believe Spirit is how God is embodied in and among us, as a living Spirit.

As with the ways we think about God, there are some terms that don't translate as well in today's setting, such as God being king, which is a masculine term. But it serves us better to minimize such terms, but not be rid of them completely. We don't have to change the poetic ways we describe God, but we can add even more expressive ways to name God and God's characteristics. We still say Father, but there are some instances of God having the qualities of a nurturing mother, as in Isaiah 49: The people of Zion said, "The LORD has turned away and forgotten us." The LORD answered, "Could a mother forget a child who nurses at her breast? Could she fail to love an infant who came from her own body? Even if a mother could forget, I will never forget you." [CEV] It will always be true that as long as we are on this side of the day of the Lord, we'll never fully know God, though as Paul reminds us in 1st Corinthians 13, we can only know God and God's love in part. Then we shall know God fully, as God knows us fully now. That's because Jesus, God's Son, has shown us what God is like. And in Spirit's way among us, we we'll learn more and more of God's love.
