

Due to the rising COVID positivity rate, it was decided to suspend in-person indoor worship beginning with Sunday, November 22nd. When the positivity rate drops closer to 5% and below, the council will discuss resuming in-person worship. Until then, we encourage our congregation to remain vigilant in following state and local safety guidelines.

Pr. Lans is working diligently to develop in-person OUTDOOR Christmas Eve worship services, with congregants wearing masks and social distancing, in addition to a pre-recorded CE worship service. More information will be available in the coming weeks.
